GERMAN I - 070

Prerequisite: None
 Elective
 Graded: Conventionally
 Time Frame: Year
 Grade: 9-12
 Credit: 1.00

German I provides an introduction to German as a world language and an overview of the cultural background of German speakers. Emphasis is placed on effective communication, acquiring proficiency in the target language, as well as the development of an appreciation for other cultures. Listening, speaking, reading, and writing are used to provide students an opportunity to develop the confidence and skills necessary to comprehend basic German and to express themselves on an elementary level in the target language.

GERMAN II - 071

Prerequisite: German I
 Elective
 Graded: Conventionally
 Time Frame: Year
 Recommendation: Teacher Recommendation
 Grade: 9-12
 Credit: 1.00

German II builds upon the grammatical and cultural basis provided in German I, as well as stressing the acquisition of skills necessary to comprehend and communicate more effectively in German within a limited scope of every day situations.

GERMAN III - 072

Prerequisite: German II
Elective Grade: 9-12
Graded: Conventionally Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year
Recommendation: Teacher Recommendation

German III emphasizes the development of communication, comprehension, listening, and writing skills on a more advanced level. Students will be exposed to a more in depth study of German culture, literature, history, science, and the arts.

HONORS GERMAN IV - 073

Prerequisite: German III
Elective Grade: 9-12
Grade: Weighted Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year
Recommendation: Teacher Recommendation

Honors German IV continues to stress the development of communication, listening, reading, and speaking skills necessary for high-level proficiency. Students are encouraged to express themselves freely, using more complex grammatical forms, and expressions as they participate in classroom discussions and conversations in the target language. This course also places emphasis on the in-depth study of German culture, literature, arts, and sciences.

FRENCH I - 078

Prerequisite: None
Elective Grade: 9-12
Graded: Conventionally Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year

French I is an introduction to basic French vocabulary and pronunciation and builds a foundation in speaking and understanding the language. Some writing and reading follow in the development of the language skills. Students also become acquainted with France and the French people and gain insight into the cultural similarities and differences between France and the United States.

FRENCH II - 079

Prerequisite: French I
Elective Grade: 9-12
Graded: Conventionally Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year
Recommendation: Teacher Recommendation

French II develops more fully the student's ability to listen, speak, read, and write in French. Oral skills will be taught through daily use of French in the classroom. Reading and writing skills are further developed. Students will continue to gain cultural knowledge.

FRENCH III - 080

Prerequisite: French II
Elective Grade: 9-12
Graded: Conventionally Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year
Recommendation: Teacher Recommendation

French III continues to develop comprehension, communication, listening, and writing skills. Students continue to encounter more advanced grammar and to perfect the French they have already learned. Aspects of culture are also studied.

HONORS FRENCH IV - 081

Prerequisite: French III
Elective Grade: 9-12
Grade: Weighted Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year
Recommendation: Teacher Recommendation

Honors French IV continues to develop the basic communication skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing with emphasis on speaking. Students delve more deeply into and explore the fine points of grammar. The course provides an introduction to the study of history and literature.

HONORS FRENCH V - 082

Prerequisite: French IV
Elective Grade: 10-12
Grade: Weighted Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year
Recommendation: Teacher Recommendation

Students will continue to increase and refine their abilities in speaking, reading, writing, and listening. The areas of reading and writing will be emphasized. The course also includes a more in-depth treatment of cultural and historical topics and exploration of advanced grammatical concepts.

LATIN I - 087

Prerequisite: None
Elective Grade: 9-12
Graded: Conventionally Credit: 1.00
Time Frame: Year

Latin I provides the basics for reading the language. Latin readings introduce the student to classical mythology, the daily life of the Romans, and Roman history. Students also explore the continuing influence of classical ideas on modern society. Emphasis on vocabulary and grammatical skills also provide related benefits in English comprehension and grammar.
